The **Nails**: Freedom in my **hands**.

Jesus carried his own cross out of the city to the place called "The Skull," which in Aramaic is Golgotha. And there they *nailed* him to the cross. (John 19:17-18)

Jesus has the power to free me from my guilt and give me forgiveness.

The **Spear**: Freedom in my **heart**.

He said, "It is finished!" Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. One of the soldiers took *a spear* and pierced Jesus' side, and blood and water gushed out. (John 19:30, 34, NLT)
