Why should I do good?

*This is a **trustworthy saying**. And I want you to **stress these things**... (Titus 3:8, NIV)*

Where should I do good?

*I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may **be careful to devote themselves** to doing what is good. (Titus 3:8, NIV)*

*One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer—at three in the afternoon. Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put **every day** to beg from those going into the temple courts... Then Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but **what I do have I give you**. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.” Taking him by the right hand, **he helped him up**, and instantly the man’s feet and ankles became strong. (Acts 3:1-2, 6-7, NIV)*
