The Plan for Who's Next

*My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old— things we have heard and known, **things our ancestors have told us**. We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell **the next generation** the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, his power, and the wonders he has done... which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children, so **the next generation** would know them, even the children yet to be born, and **they in turn would tell their children**. Then they would **put their trust in God**... (Psalm 78:1–7, NIV)*

1) **My** Chair.

2) The **Previous** Chair.

*I will utter hidden things, things from of old— things we have heard and known, **things our ancestors have told us**. (Psalm 78:3, NIV)*

3) The **Next** Chair.

*We will tell **the next generation** the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, his power, and the wonders he has done... which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children, so **the next generation** would know them, even the children yet to be born, and **they in turn would tell their children**. Then they would **put their trust in God**... (Psalm 78:4–7, NIV)*

Who will ever tell the story of the chair you set out for them?


The Path for Who's Next
